WORD CHOICE: Storytelling | Emotion

Repetition

**STORYTELLING:** The art of storytelling engages audience members from start to finish. Storytelling is a mental picture-story with a moral ending

**EMOTION:** Emotion within your speech inspires a heartfelt reaction through positive word choice. Emotion is a strong feeling that creates a connection.

**REPETITION:** Repetition is voice commands that make your audience members respond directly to you. Repetition is the ability to get your audience repeating back to you a word or statement that has been spoken

**VOICE DYNAMICS :** Change of Tone | Dramatic Pause | Voice Projection

**CHANGE OF TONE**: Change of tone is tone inflection that keeps the interest of your audience.

Change of tone is a way of speaking that gives a range of variety in the tone of a speaker's voice

**DRAMATIC PAUSE**: Dramatic pause makes the audience reflect and put emphasis on what was said in a previous statement. Dramatic pause is a short moment of silence of 3 to 5 seconds between a word or statement that creates an intriguing suspense.

**VOICE PROJECTION:** Voice projection is the ability to make your voice create a climax moment during your speech that leaves audience members at the edge of their seats. Voice projection is a climax moment in the speech that places a strong emphasis on a word or statement.

**BODY LANGUAGE:** Hand Gestures Eye Contact Facial Expressions

**HAND GESTURES:** Hand gestures provides additional meaning to your speech through specific bodily movements on stage. Hand

**EYE CONTACT:** Eye contact is the ability to get your audience to connect with you and be actively engaged during your presentation. Eye contact is a gaze with the eyes of 3 to 5 seconds that grabs the attention of a person.
